



ADULT READER AND INFORMATION SERVICES COMMITTEE (ARIS)

- A. **GOALS:** To improve patron access to adult materials, information and technology through Inland Library system and networking channels.
- B. **OBJECTIVES:**
1. To broaden staff awareness of resources outside individual libraries.
 2. To work toward a coordinated purchasing of adult materials among ILS member libraries.
 3. To work toward coordinating reference services among ILS member libraries.
- C. **FUNCTIONS:**
1. To develop Interlibrary Library Loan and Interlibrary Reference services, including telecommunications and delivery systems.
 2. To investigate, recommend, and implement methods of improving access to materials of System members.
- D. **STRUCTURE:**
1. The Adult Reader and Information Services Committee shall be composed of an ILS staff member, and representatives from each System library, and shall meet quarterly.
 2. Ad hoc committees shall be created as needed for special projects. Each committee will be drawn from the staffs of System libraries.
